Context: You will join the Federal Advocacy and Institutional Relations Unit (AIR) of Humanity & Inclusion (Handicap International-HI: www.hi.org/) in Brussels. This unit coordinates, organizes, manages and implements the activities related to advocacy for HI network.

You will work under the supervision of the Humanitarian Advocacy Manager. Throughout the internship, you will be given opportunity to experiment varied tasks, and be given regular feedback on your performance to help you grow.

General objective: We are seeking a motivated intern to support our advocacy efforts towards principled and inclusive responses to humanitarian crises.

Main tasks:

1. Monitor humanitarian policy trends in countries where HI has national associations and other influencing States.
